Do you need the ASSET Test?

The ASSET (that stands for Assessment of Skills for Successful Entry and Transfer) helps assure your success by placing you in course work for which you are adequately prepared.

The ASSET measures the level of writing, reading and numerical skills. Many program texts require high reading or math levels. These skills are the foundation for success, and if scores indicate an area of weakness, the you will be advised to enroll in classes designed to improve those skills as a prerequisite for some courses.

Students who are enrolling full time, and those taking a math or English course for the first time at ACC are required to take the ASSET. Because proper placement is a key to success, however, the ASSET is recommended for all students.
