ACC accounting, business, medical assistant programs earn accreditation

The Association of Collegiate Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP) has accredited Alpena Community College for its associate in applied science degree programs in accounting and small business management, and the associate in applied science program for medical assistant has been approved by the Council for Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP).
