



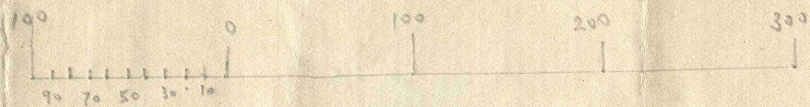

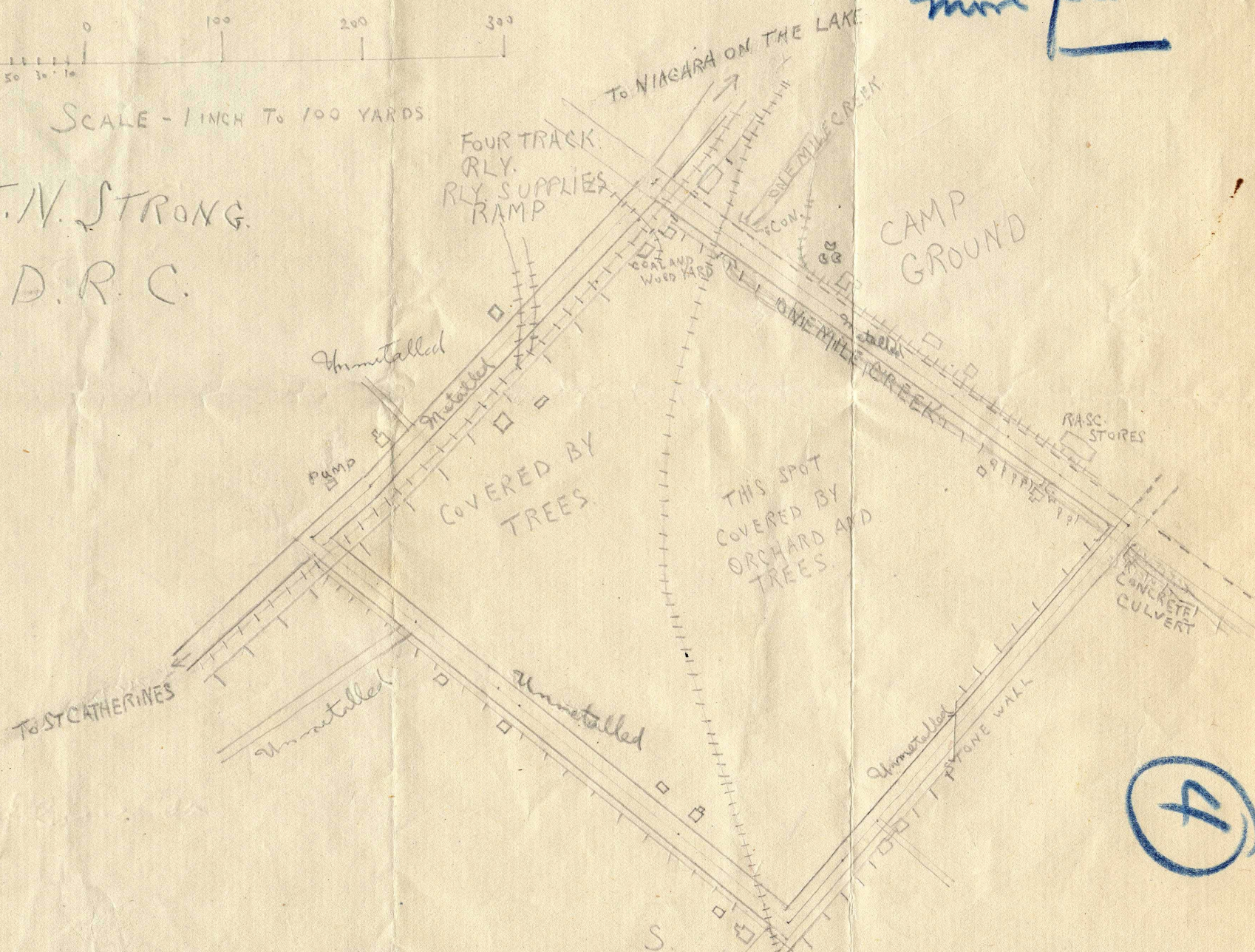
MAGNETIC VARIATION
