Program Refund Procedures

Program Cancellation:

A full refund will be issued for classes cancelled by Parks & Recreation. No administration fee will apply.

Requests for Refunds:

A program refund will be issued if received a minimum of five (5) days prior to the start of the program. The administration fee will apply. After this time, a refund will be considered up to the third class of a session for medical or compassionate circumstances only. Refunds will be prorated based on the number of classes already taken and the administration fee will apply. A medical note may be required.

Administration Fee:

A 15% fee will apply to the prorated amount for all refunds. Refunds can be issued at any Parks and Recreation facility or over the phone, providing the credit card name matches the account name in the registration system. The receipt must be presented in person in order to process a refund if the credit card and account information do not match.

Can We Help? **Financial Assistance Program**

Brantford Parks & Recreation would like to ensure that all children and youth of our municipality have the opportunity to access recreation and leisure services. To help make this possible, financial assistance to qualified applicants, for most registered and dropin programs, may be offered if funding and the programs are available.

How do I apply? Please call 519-756-1500 for Community Centres/Bell Homestead programs or 519-756-9900 for Wayne Gretzky Centre programs/ swim lessons, prior to registration.

Support Workers

If your child requires a support worker at school, please call us to discuss if the same support is required when attending a Parks & Recreation program.

Returned Cheques

Sometimes mistakes happen. To cover costs, a \$40 administrative fee must be charged for all cheques returned by a bank. We will require that the original cheque be replaced with a cash or debit payment.

Bronze Medallion and Emergency First Aid

Bronze Medallion develops physical fitness, decision-making and judgement skills in preparation for challenging rescues of increased risk. Candidates must be able to complete a 500m swim in 15 minutes or less.

Duration: 28 hours of instruction

Bronze Cross

Bronze Cross is a preparation course for National Lifequard designed to teach advanced training techniques, principles of emergency procedures, teamwork, and use of special equipment. Candidates must be able to complete a 600m swim in 18 minutes or less.

Prerequisites: Bronze Medallion and Emergency First Aid

Duration: 28 hours of instruction

National Lifeguard (Pool Option)

National Lifeguard certification is Canada's professional lifeguard standard. National Lifeguard training emphasizes prevention and effective rescue response in emergencies. Prerequisites: Minimum 16 years of age and Bronze Cross and Standard First Aid (certified by one of the following four agencies: Lifesaving Society, Canadian Red Cross, St. John Ambulance and Canadian Ski Patrol).

Duration: 40 hours of instruction

Material Required: ALERT: Lifequarding in Action \$51.00, CPR Mask \$19.50

Step 1: Attend the "Instructors Course - Part 1: Screening"

The Instructors Course is a requirement to attend prior to beginning the Instructor Course. All manuals will be distributed at the screening, swimming strokes will be assessed, peer taching assignments and online module training requirements will be discussed.

Step 2: Attend the "Instructors Course - Part 2: Course"

The Swimming Instructors course combines two industry leading Instructor certifications.

Water Safety Instructor: Upon successful completion of this program candidates will be able to instruct the swimming lesson program (Water Safety Program). Sessions include developing skills in the areas of class management, teaching, evaluation, leadership, communication and administration. Prerequisites: 15 years of age and one of the following Bronze Cross or National Lifeguard.

Lifesaving Instructor: Upon successful completion of this program candidates will be able to instruct lifesaving and leadership programs (Bronze Levels). Sessions include learing to organize, plan, teach and evaluate lifesaving and first aid skills and resuscitation techniques in the Lifesaving Society's lifesaving and first aid awards. Prerequisites: 16 years of age and one of the following Bronze Cross or National Lifeguard.

STARFISH: AGES 4 TO 12 MONTHS

Babies must be able to hold their head up. Focus on water orientation & safety for caregivers and their children. Children experience buoyancy, movement, entries, songs and play in the water.

DUCK: AGES 10 MONTHS TO 2.5 YEARS.

For toddlers and older babies with parent. Toddlers build confidence in water through games, songs and water play. Focus on water orientation & safety.

SEA TURTLE: AGES 2 TO 3 YEARS.

Transitional level for baby and parent. Focus on moving forward, backwards assisted, front, back float and recovery assisted and use buoyant objects for support.

SEA OTTER: AGES 3 TO 6 YEARS.

Parent participation not required in the water. Focus is on introductory level for preschoolers with little or no water experience. Develops skills in floats, glides and swimming and builds awareness of deep water and safe entries.

SALAMANDER: AGES 3 TO 6 YEARS.

Parent participation not required in the water. Focus is on learning new swimming skills including assisted floats and glides, rollover and front swim for 2m and jumping into chest deep water.

SUNFISH: AGES 3 TO 6 YEARS.

Parent participation not required in the water. Focus is on good judgement in, on and around the water. Work on stroke and skill progression & deep water entries.

CROCODILE: AGES 3 TO 6 YEARS.

Parent participation not required in the water. Focus is on independent glides and kicking in deep water, building endurance for front and back swims to 5m. Participants learn about dolphin kick with introduction to synchro skills.

WHALE: AGES 3 TO 6 YEARS.

Parent participation not required in the water. Focus is on deep water skills, building endurance for front and back swims up to 7M. Participants learn about dolphin kick with introduction synchro skills. Participants also learn about throwing assists to help another person in the water.

We now have a specific swim lesson picture days. For your child's safety and due to the Privacy Act (R.S.O.1990, chapter f.31), parents will only be allowed to take pictures of their children swimming on the last day of their swim lessons only.

We strive to ensure your child succeeds in their swim lesson. If you have any questions about their progress, please speak to your instructor.

SWIM KIDS 1: AGES 6 TO 14 YEARS.

Focus is for the beginner participant, orientation to the water and the pool area. Includes the following: shallow water entries and exits, submerging head and rhythmic breathing, front/back floats, glides and rollovers. Participants work towards completion of 5m front swim.

SWIM KIDS 2: AGES 6 TO 14 YEARS.

Focus is on building skills learned in Swim Kids 1. Introduction to deep water activities and proper use of Personal Flotation devices. Skills included the following: Rhythmic breathing, front/back floats, front/back/side glides with kick, rollover glides and front swim 5m.

SWIM KIDS 3: AGES 6 TO 14 YEARS.

Focus is on introduction to front crawl as well as making wise choices on when and where to swim. Deep water skills such as surface dives, changing direction and sitting dives are introduced. Front swim increased to 15m. Building on skills from Level 1&2.

SWIM KIDS 4: AGES 6 TO 14 YEARS.

Focus is on self-safety, kneeling dives, surface support, front/side glide combinations and back glide and kick with shoulder roll. Front swim is increased to 30m.

SWIM KIDS 5: AGES 6 TO 14 YEARS.

Back crawl, whip kick, sculling skills and stride dives are introduced. Front and back crawl is increased to 45m. Boating safety will also be covered in this level.

SWIM KIDS 6: AGES 6 TO 14 YEARS.

Front and back crawl continue to be refined, elementary backstroke, safety on the ice, rescue of others with throwing assists, treading water and the front dive is introduced. Front/back crawl is increased to 75 m.

SWIM KIDS 7: AGES 6 TO 14 YEARS

This level builds skills and endurance for the front crawl (50m), back crawl (50m) and elementary back stroke (25m) and introduces whip kick on the front. Swimming endurance is increased to a 150m swim.

SWIM KIDS 8: AGES 6 TO 14 YEARS

This level is an introduction to breast stroke (15m) and feet-first surface dives. Endurance is built on a 300m swim. Front crawl and back crawl distances are increased to 75m each.

SWIM KIDS 9: AGES 6 TO 14 YEARS

This level refines the front crawl (100m), back crawl (100m), elementary back stroke (50m) and breast stroke (25m), and encourages swimmers to combine different kicks for fitness (3 mins). Endurance is built through a 400m swim.

SWIM KIDS 10: AGES 6 TO 14 YEARS

This level is a final assessment of the strokes for technique and distance (front crawl 100m, back crawl 100m, elementary back stroke 50m, breast stroke 50m and sidestroke 25m). Endurance is built using the dolphin kick (vertical) and a 500m swim.

To set-up semi-private lessons (two swimmers to one instructor) you must do the following:


1. Register the first swimmer into a regular Private Lesson (at the regular private lesson rate)

Unfortunately, we will not be able to permit a child (ages 3 to 6) to be in a semi-private lesson combined with a child that is capable of swimming 25+ metres of the pool due to safety and supervision requirements.




Year-Round Rain Barrel Sales

Summer Watering Reminders

Watering restrictions are in effect during June, July and August of every year



- Even numbered addresses can water on even calendar days and odd numbered addresses can water on odd calendar days
- Watering can only occur between the hours of 7:00 am to 9:00 am and/or 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm
- Hand-held watering vessels are exempt
- Washing vehicles in a residential zone is permitted at any time if the hose is equipped with a shut-off spray nozzle or bucket of water is used with a sponge/rag
- Watering of planter pots, patio planters, hanging planters and the like, are exempt
