Program Age

You must be turning the minimum age during the program to register.

Program Refund Procedures

Program Cancellation:

A full refund will be issued for classes cancelled by Parks & Recreation. No administration fee will apply.

Requests for Refunds:

A program refund will be issued if received a minimum of five (5) days prior to the start of the program. The administration fee will apply. After this time, a refund will be considered up to the third class of a session for medical or compassionate circumstances only. Refunds will be prorated based on the number of classes already taken and the administration fee will apply. A medical note may be required.

Administration Fee:

A 15% fee will apply to the prorated amount for all refunds. Refunds can be issued at any Parks and Recreation facility or over the phone, providing the credit card name matches the account name in the registration system. The receipt must be presented in person in order to process a refund if the credit card and account information do not match.

Can We Help?

Financial Assistance Program

Brantford Parks & Recreation would like to ensure that all children and youth of our municipality have the opportunity to access recreation and leisure services. To help make this possible, financial assistance to qualified applicants, for most registered and drop-in programs, may be offered if funding and the programs are available.

How do I apply? Please call 519-756-1500 for Community Centres/Bell Homestead programs or 519-756-9900 for Wayne Gretzky Centre programs/swim lessons, prior to registration.

Support Workers


If your child requires a support worker at school, please call us to discuss if the same support is required when attending a Parks & Recreation program.

Returned Cheques

Sometimes mistakes happen. To cover costs, a \$40 administrative fee must be charged for all cheques returned by a bank. We will require that the original cheque be replaced with a cash or debit payment.

Pre-School Information

Staff ratio for preschool programs is 1:7. Your child must be fully toilet-trained to attend any program where you are not required to join. If you are bringing snacks please ensure they are peanut free! If your child is attending a program please wait in the lobby area.

- Those who are able to pass the Facility Swim Test, MUST be accompanied by a parent/guardian at least 15 years of age that maintains visual contact and remains within the pool enclosure at all times.
- Those who are unable to pass the Facility Swim Test, MUST be directly supervised by a parent/guardian at least 15 years of age, who is in the water wearing bathing attire, within arm's reach, and able to render immediate assistance.
- 1 parent/guardian who is at least 15 years of age may assume responsibility for up to 3 swimmers, requiring direct supervision.
- The ratio of can increase up to 8 swimmers, requiring direct supervision, if all children are wearing a lifejacket.

PRESCHOOL 1

Your preschooler will learn to get in and out of the water and jump into chest deep water. They will do floats and glides on their front and back, and learn to get their face wet and blow bubbles underwater.

PRESCHOOL 2

You're preschooler will learn to jump into chest deep water by themselves, and how to get in and get out wearing a lifejacket. They'll also submerge and exhale underwater. While they wear a lifejacket they'll glide on their front and back.

PRESCHOOL 3

Your child will try both jumping and a sideways entry into deep water while they wear a lifejacket and they'll recover objects from the bottom in waist-deep water. They'll also work on kicking and gliding through the water on their front and back.

PRESCHOOL 4

Your child will learn to do solo jumps into deeper water and how to get out by themselves. They'll do sideways entries and open their eyes underwater. They'll also master a short (5m) swim on their front wearing a lifejacket and gliding and kicking on their side.

PRESCHOOL 5

Your child will get more confident with a forward roll entry wearing a lifejacket and treading water for 10 sec. They'll work on front and back crawl swims for 5m, interval training and get a giggle out of whip kick.

SWIMMER 1

Your child will become comfortable jumping into water with and without a lifejacket. They'll learn to open their eyes, exhale and hold their breath underwater. They'll also work on floats, glides and kicking through the water on their front and back.

SWIMMER 2

Your child will learn to feel comfortable jumping into deeper water and learn to fall sideways into the water wearing a lifejacket. They'll also learn to support themselves on the surface without an aid, whip kick, swim 10m on their front and back, and we will introduce them to flutter kick interval training (4 x 5m).

SWIMMER 3

Your child will dive and do front somersaults, and handstands in the water. They'll work on their front crawl for 15m, back crawl and whip kick for 10 m. Their flutter kick interval training will increase to 4 x 15m.

SWIMMER 4

Your child will swim 5m underwater and complete lengths of front and back crawl, whip kick, and breaststroke arms with breathing. They will also finish the Canadian Swim to Survive® Standard then finish with front crawl sprints over 25m and 4 x 25m front or back crawl interval training.

SWIMMER 5

Your swimmer will master their shallow dives, cannonball entries, eggbeater kicks, and in-water backward somersaults. They'll refine their front and back crawl over 50m, and breaststroke over 25m. Then they'll pick up the pace doing 25m sprints and two interval training stints: 4 x 50m front or back crawl; and 4 x 15 m breaststroke.

SWIMMER 6

Your swimmer will rise to the challenge of more advanced skills including stride entries, compact jumps and lifesaving kicks like eggbeater and scissor kick. They'll develop strength and power in head-up breaststroke sprints over 25 m. They'll easily swim lengths of front crawl, back crawl, and breaststroke, and complete a 300 m workout.

ROOKIE PATROL/SWIMMER 7

Your swimmer will continue stroke development with 50 m swims of front crawl, back crawl and breaststroke. Lifesaving sport skills include a 25 m obstacle swim and 15 m object carry. First aid focuses on assessment of conscious victims, contacting EMS, and treatment for bleeding. Fitness improves in 350 m workouts and 100 m timed swims.

RANGER PATROL/SWIMMER 8

Your swimmer will develop better strokes over 75 m swims of each stroke. They tackle lifesaving sport skills in a lifesaving medley, timed object support and rescue with a buoyant aid. First aid focuses on assessment of unconscious victims, treatment of victims in shock and obstructed airway procedures. Skill drills develop a strong lifesaving foundation.

STAR PATROL/SWIMMER 9

Your swimmer will be challenged with 600 m workouts, 300 m timed swims and a 25 m object carry. Strokes are refined over 100 m swims. First aid focuses on treatment of bone or joint injuries and respiratory emergencies including asthma and allergic reactions. Lifesaving skills include defense methods, victim removals and rolling over and supporting a victim face up in shallow water.

SILVER SWIMMERS

It's never too late to improve your swimming or learn a new technique. This program is designed for non-swimmer seniors who want to improve their strokes. Come on out and see what you can learn! Class will be followed by 15 minutes in the warm water pool.

ADULT LESSONS

Swimming is a life skill that everyone should have. This program is designed for anyone over the age of 14 that would love to learn how to swim. From non-swimmer to beginners and swimmers wanting stroke correction, this class will suit any level of swimmer.

WATER SAFETY

Basic water safety skills are essential. Swimming pools, lakes and rivers offer year-round fun if they are enjoyed safely. But every year about 160 people drown in Ontario. Drowning is the second leading cause of accidental death for children under five years old, and statistics show that children under 12, boaters, young men and seniors 65+ are at greatest risk.

 2. Call (519) 756-9900 to register the second swimmer (at an additional, reduced rate)

Note: For safety precautions, the two swimmers being registered in the semi-private lessons must be no greater than 2 levels apart (e.g. Swimmer 1 and Swimmer 3) or otherwise approved by the Aquatic Supervisor based on individual circumstances. Unfortunately, we will not be able to permit a child (ages 3 to 6) to be in a semi-private lesson combined with a child that is capable of swimming 25+ metres of the pool due to safety and supervision requirements.







The following items are not recyclable



Coffee cups, styrofoam, plastic bags, chip bags, and snack food sleeves **CANNOT** be recycled

Other items that CANNOT be recycled include: mirror/window glass, drinking glasses, ceramics, clothing and textiles, batteries, light bulbs, and electronics. These items can be disposed of at the Mohawk Street Landfill Site during our Household Hazardous Waste Events (see reverse for dates and times).

How can you help reduce recycling contamination?

1. Look for recycling labels 1-7 on plastic packaging to help identify if it is recyclable or not (plastics 1-7 can be recycled)
2. Remove metal caps and lids on glass jars and bottles
3. Empty and rinse containers - any remaining food waste will contaminate recyclables
4. If in doubt, check before you chuck using the [recycle coach](#) app
