As your Member of Provincial Parliament, I want to wish you a most productive, fulfilling and rewarding 2017. With the start of a new year, a sense of rejuvenation and renewal opens us to new possibilities and opportunities. It is my hope that this calendar will be a way to make plans and dream big dreams. I trust that it will also be a valuable source of information for accessing the many community services available to you in Brant.

It has been my honour and privilege to serve as your MPP since 1999. I am proud of all we have accomplished in Brant over the past 18 years working together. This past year was a big year for Brant. For the past decade, I have been working tirelessly to provide solutions to the growing commuting trend that takes the people of Brant in and out of Hamilton, Toronto, and surrounding areas. Working in conjunction with city partners, our efforts came to fruition when the Ministry of Transportation announced in 2016 that Brantford would be served with a GO bus to Aldershot. Improving the commuting experience for the people of Brant remains a priority for me. I will continue to work towards improving the commute in and out of Brant. My vision involves quick, seamless and affordable transportation for the people of Brant. More work on this front will continue. Your feedback is always welcomed.

I couldn't be happier that my work to increase hospice space for Brant has led to significant success this past year. Our region has received funding for four additional beds at the Hankinson House. Through a partnership with the provincial government and a very generous donation from the Hankinson Foundation, we are able to provide care to the people of Brant at the end of their life in a dignified and respectful atmosphere. Families are invited and welcomed to spend time at the hospice with their loved ones at the Hankinson House, which has many open, spacious and comfortable meeting rooms for visiting and socializing. The Hankinson House is considered to be a model of care for all of Ontario and I am proud that we were able to build it here in Brant.

At the last election, I pledged to work on creating a more age-friendly Brant. Statistics show that our riding is home to an increasing number of seniors. I promised to open a discussion on making Brant more accessible, innovative, and community-oriented, in order to make our community welcoming for people of all ages. To date, we have organized eight roundtable discussions focusing on improving services for seniors in eight sectors: outdoor spaces and buildings, transportation, housing, respect and social inclusion, social participation, civic participation and employment, communication and information, and community support and health service. A final report will be submitted to decision-makers at all levels to guide them in what we need and want in Brant.

I strongly believe that collaboration is key to politics. This is why I strive to take a collaborative, cooperative approach as your democratically elected representative, knowing that consultations and round-table discussions lead to the best policy decisions possible. And while I am proud of the work that has been accomplished, I recognize that there is still more to do. I have worked hard to make the riding of Brant a better place for us to live, work, play and raise a family and I will continue to advocate every day for the people of the riding of Brant. Your voice at Queen's Park will be heard.






