## ATTENDANCE REGULATIONS



The excellent attendance of many — not the exceptional attendance of a few is essential in Kiwanis. Obviously our Club can only attain the desired results in fellowship and achievement in proportion to the attendance recorded by our membership.

The following clauses are excerpts from the official attendance rules.

"An unexcused absence from forty per cent of the meetings during either half of the Club year or from four consecutive meetings jeopardizes your membership in the Club. An absence may be made up in any one of the following ways—

(1) At a regular meeting or a round table meeting of any other Kiwanis Club during the calendar month in which the absence occurs or within six days immediately prior to or following that month:

(2) By attending a regularly constituted meeting of our Board of Directors held within the same calendar month or within seven days immediately prior to or following that month. (Our directors meetings are regularly called for the first Thursday of each month:)

(3) By attending a regular meeting or Board of Directors meeting of a Key Club or Circle K Club:

(4) By attending a planned divisional or district convention - conference or meeting during the calendar month in which the absence occurs or within six days immediately following that month:

(5) A member shall not be given credit for attendance under clauses one and three of the above unless the Secretary of the Club visited furnishes an official certificate of such attendance to the Secretary of our Club:

(6) A "senior" member is required to attend at least 12 regular club meetings during any administrative year.
