

DEAR SIR,

I feel a delicacy in troubling you on this subject, but I know of no other method to obtain the desired information.

Be pleased to inform me what sums of money, Benajah Mallory received for each of the following persons belonging to captain Frisbee's company, in the Canadian corps, viz. Stephen Petton, John Bennett, William M'Carty, James M'Gee, James M'Laughlin; also, for Cary Macellus, and if you can find the muster roll of captain Hamilton's rifle company, and inform me if Elnathan Thrasher appears thereon, you would do me a great favor; said Thrasher died at Sackett's Harbor in the summer of the last campaign. Please inform me if said Mallory received his (Thrasher's) back pay; he had a power for that purpose, and letters of administration. Says "he did not receive the money, and has lost the papers." Major Mallory was at Washington, last witter, with the claims of the above persons, and does not give a satisfactory account. If he has dealt honestly, there can be no impropriety in making the inquiry; if he has acted the knave, he will probably be brought to justice. I once caught him incog. by the side of a widow, and cheated her out of \$100, besides the discount on southern money. Please also inform me the amount he received for the widow of lieutenant Israel Willcox, of the twelve months volunteers, who died on the Niagara frontier, and what kind of money he received.

Sir, if you have a clerk in the office that will write an answer to the above inquiries, I will inclose any sum that shall be mentioned.

by proper authority.

For the three years last past, I we been the collector of direct tax and internal duties, for e district in which most of these claimants reside, and am rsonally acquainted with most part of them. In consesence of the numerous and urgent applications of these aimants to me, for assistance in this business, I am induced, r, in their behalf, respectfully to submit their case to your onsideration, and if not incompatible with the rules of. our office, do request that such information may be given e or them, as will enable the several soldiers to ascertain e amount received on each of their claims, and by whom ceived. I am, sir, interested in a trifling degree, in ascerining the amount received on these claims, as I have furshed money to some of these claimants for the subsistence their families, on the supposition that their claims would e established, and when established, to receive only the mount lent. I have been able, sir, to ascertain that those aims in which I had a personal interest, have been estaished. It is therefore, at the particular request of the seve-I claimants, and with a view to aid them in obtaining their ist rights, that I have interfered myself in their behalf. I ill refer you, sir, to the honorable Samuel H. Smith, Comhissioner of the Revenue, for any information relating to y character, standing, &c. &c.




