Golf on one of the many courses just a short drive from downtown Belleville; from a quiet Par 3 to championship caliber courses.

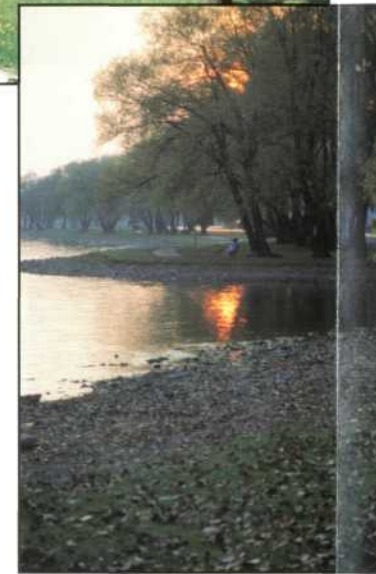
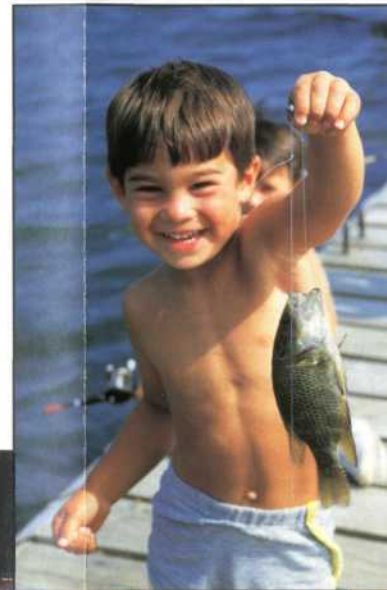
## Toss a line in the Bay
