The feed storage operation is owned jointly by the North Carolina State Port Authority and three massive farm operations.

The facility is also of interest to Canada's agricultural community as at least some of the grain shipments, delivered there for redistribution, are of Canadian products.

EMS-TECH has also designed new patented gate feeders which can completely control movement of bulk materials both by load weight or speed.

Based in Belleville, the company has feelers in the international community, where it does most of its business, including representatives in Europe and China.

Other projects under way include self-unloading equipment for ocean-going bulk carrying vessels and specialized equipment for large sewage processing operations, both cylindrical and rectangular. Some of these include bridge-mounted scrapers for a large sewage treatment plant in Trenton, NJ.

For the increasing number of EMS-TECH customers around the world, the name of Belleville is becoming associated with big.
