Earlier this week, a 53-foot classroom rolled up to the front doors of Frost the Mover on Wall-

"It was something else to see," explained company president Jim Best shortly after the North American Van Lines mobile training facility was loaded with his employees for a day-long session.

Equipped with a fullyfunctional 14-seat multimedia classroom, Best said h \$250,000 trailer and its crew have been crisscrossing the country to better train North American Van Line

employees since late last year.

Training offered through the facility is extensive, Best said, "Covering basically all aspects of our business — from handling and wrapping furniture and items to administrative and secretarial duties."

Last year the trailer's schedule made for stops in larger city centres, such as Toronto and Montre-

al, Best recalled, however this year the facility is hoping to train employees at all 96 North American Van Lines offices in Canada.

"This is the first time it's has come to Belleville... which is quite a big deal to us. Now the little agent in Belleville, Ontario can get the same treatment and training as the big guys in Toronto."

Meanwhile, Best and his staff continue to gear up for a special company milestone next year: Frost the Mover's 100th anniver-
