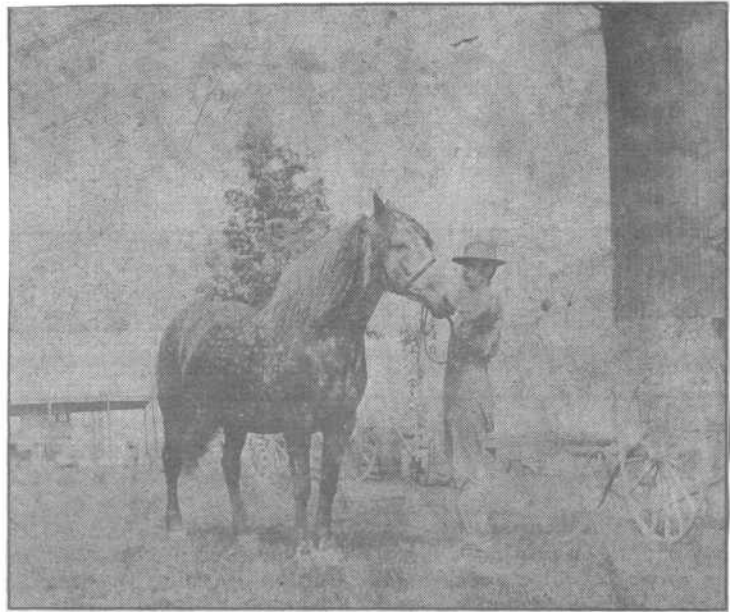


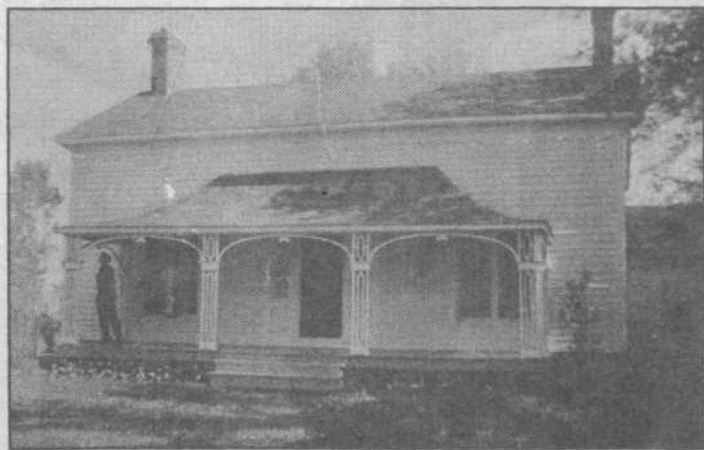
Anderson, James Way
