Funeral for *1990* top musician on Thursday

Visitation for long-time prominent Belleville musician Jack Green continues today at the Burke Funeral Home from 2 to 4 p.m. and 7 to 9 p.m.

The funeral for Mr. Green, who died Monday in Hastings Manor at the age of 94, will be held at 10:30 a.m. Thursday in the Salvation Army Citadel, Victoria Avenue and Lingham Street.

Bandmaster for the local Salvation Army and wind instrument instructor for almost 60 years, Mr. Green came to Belleville from his native Wales at the age of 33.

Mr. Green was recipient of the highest honor the Salvation Army can bestow, the Order of the Founder.

A former Belleville resident and now a retired head of the international Salvation Army, Gen. Arnold Brown, will give the main message for the funeral service.
