PICTON — The late Dr. Donald W. Gullett, who, for 17 years, practised general dentistry in Picton, has been honored during the annual memorial lecture of the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario.

Dr. Gullett who died in 1973, graduated from the Royal College in 1923 became one of the best known and most honored practitioners in Canadian dentistry during his 50-year career.

In 1936, Dr. Gullett was elected to serve as a director of the Royal College of Dental Surgeons.

He was later appointed secretary of the RCDS and in 1942 became its Registrar. In 1945, he was named treasurer of the college.

For 22 years he was secretary of the Canadian Dental Association, an office he undertook in 1942.

After his retirement Dr. Gullett wrote the book The History of Dentistry in Canada.

He was the recipient of the Medal of Service of the Order of Canada.
