**A** piece of Ron Stewart will be going home with several hundred alumni and former staff attending Bellefonte Collegiate Institute's 75th reunion next month.

That is because a limited edition pen and ink sketch of BCI done in 1992 by the retired educator will be presented to everyone attending the June 6-8 event.

"It's a real honour to have something that you created appreciated and shared with so

many people," said the 62-year-old Joyce Crescent resident who taught at BCI in its last two years of its existence.

"BCI renewed my enthusiasm in the latter part of my career in education and to give something back to the school is nice."

Stewart's sketch of BCI is already in the hands of hundreds of people. The BCI student council gave each student and staff member Stewart's sketch as a farewell present when the high school closed its doors in June of 1992.
