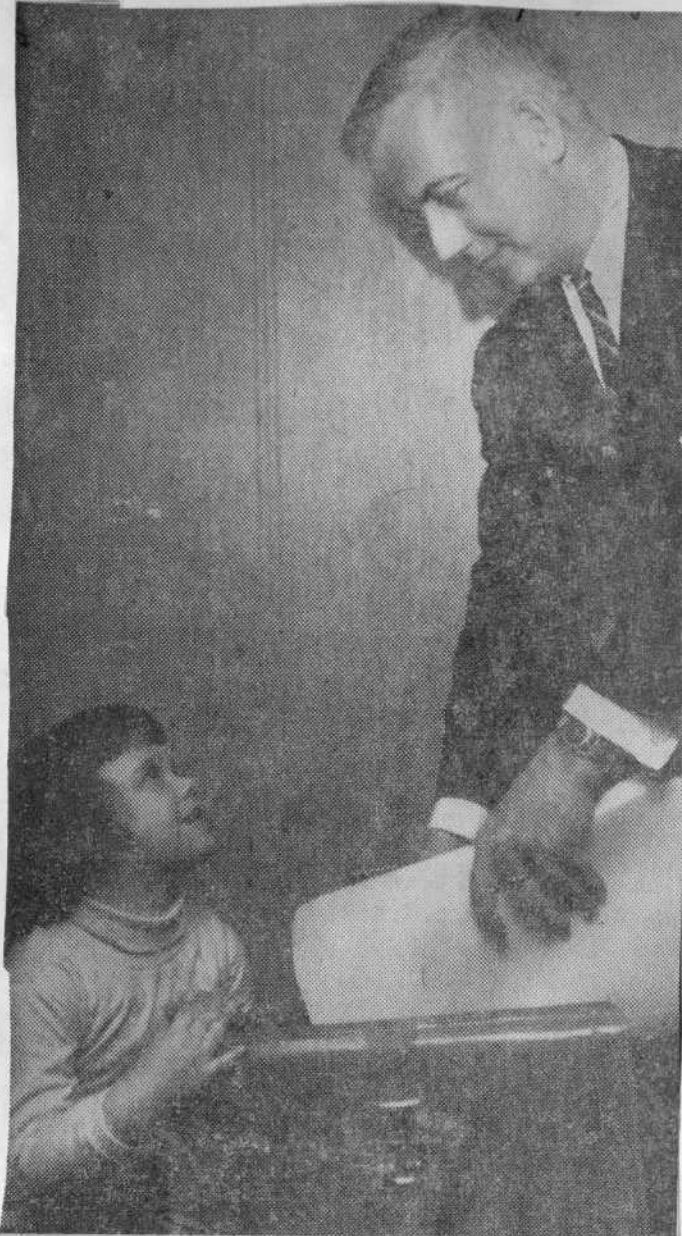

S. Hastings Member To Head Delegation

Robert Temple, M.P. Hastings South, has been chosen to head Canada's political committee at the forthcoming NATO talks in Paris.

Mr. Temple leaves from Ottawa today with the parliamentary defence committee, on its annual tour of Canadian bases in Europe.

During the committee's visit, the conference of NATO parliamentarians is scheduled to start November 16th and continue through to November 20th.

Mr. Temple will deliver the keynote speech of the Canadian delegation.

Canadian bases included on the committee tour are Soest and the RCAF No. 3 Wing at Zweibruecken.

Among his constituency activities last weekend before leaving for the NATO sessions was a speech by Mr. Temple to Liberals at Stoco.

In his remarks he emphasized the economic achievements of the Liberal government since taking office.

The present economic boom

had vindicated the government's policies, he said.

It not only had restored order to the national finances but a budgetary surplus now was a surety.
