Wellington
Doctor Retires
As Coroner

PICTON (Staff) — Resignation of Dr. R. A. Thompson of Wellington as a Prince Edward County coroner has been accepted by the Ontario Government, in keeping with an amendment to the Coroner's Act that coroners retire at the age of seventy. Dr. Thompson had applied for retirement prior to this ruling.

This leaves only Dr. C. R.

Richmond as a coroner residing in the county but two Belleville doctors serve Ameliasburg Township.

Through desiring to take things a bit easier, Dr. Thompson continues to lead a busy life as the village's only doctor. Graduating in 1924, he has practised in Wellington for 39 years, since 1927. He has also

been coroner during that period.
