G. B. Hyde Said Slated For City Job

The appointment of ex-Mayor Gerald B. Hyde as city personnel officer and purchasing agent to fill the position left vacant by the resignation of A. L. Jobey, is expected to be made at the next meeting of city council.

Confirmation of the appointment was not available from city officials today but Mr. Hyde told The Intelligencer he had been advised his application for the position had been accepted.

Mr. Hyde said he would be resigning his present position as chairman of the Public Utilities Commission.

Before assuming his new position early next month Mr. Hyde said he would close out the Front Street plumbing business which the family has operated for the past 48 years. Mr. Hyde has been in the business for 21 years.
