J.W. Jenkins, well-known former proprietor of the Hotel Qhinte, died Thursday in his 52nd year in Kingston General Hospital.

Mr. Jenkins assumed operation of the hotel from his father, Gerald, and later sold it in 1971. He was the third member of his family to operate the establishment, founded by his grandfather in 1895.

Funeral will be held Saturday at 10 a.m. from St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church with interment at Belleville Cemetery.

He is survived by his wife, Doreen, two daughters Kristin of Terra Cotta and Laura, at home, a step-son, David Greer also at home and a step-daughter Mrs. Robert Rush of Belleville.
