Sheriff Appointed For P. E. County

PICTON (Staff) — A 43-year-old Picton resident, Keith Maddox, has been appointed sheriff of Prince Edward County.

The announcement was made today from the office of the Attorney-General by A. R. Russell, inspector of legal offices.

Mr. Maddox, whose appointment is effective immediately, has been employed by the sheriff's office as a deputy for five years. The office of county sheriff has been vacant since the death of Sheriff Her-

bert J. Colliver last October.

Concern regarding the government's failure to make a new appointment has been expressed in recent months by members of the local lawyer's association and municipal officials.

Mr. Maddox, a native of Fonthill, came to Picton in 1950 as an employee of the Bank of Nova Scotia. He later accepted a job with the sheriff's office. Mr. Maddox is married to the former Donna Cooper of Picton. The couple has two children, William and Kathy.
