# Belleville Nurse In Afghanistan

Corinne Marlatt, R.N., daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Norman Marlatt of 1224 Brass Dr. Kingston, has recently arrived in Afghanistan to serve a two year duty tour with Medico, a service of CARE.

Miss Marlatt once worked at Belleville General Hospital and is a 1971 graduate of the Edith Cavell Regional School of Nursing affiliated with the hospital. She was also employed as a staff nurse for four years at the University of Alberta Hospital in Edmonton.

The nurse now joins a team of physicians and nurses at the new Republic Hospital in the Afghan capital of Kabul.

Miss Marlatt will serve in supervisory and teaching capacities in the surgical wards, intensive care unit and recovery room of the hospital. Her main duty will be to upgrade the training of local nurses and students, according to a news release from CARE.

In Afghanistan, The Medico section of CARE focuses on the postgraduate training of physicians as well as expansion of in-service training for nurses. Medico long-term personnel also conduct programs in the Dominican Republic, Honduras, Indonesia, Nicaragua and Tunisia.
