PICTON — A former North Marysburgh Township councillor, deputy-reeve and township clerk, Sherman Bowers, 67, died suddenly, Monday morning, at his Waupoos residence, following a heart attack.

He had spent the previous weekend working at the Picton Fair, where, for more than the past ten years, he has tallied the gate receipts.

Services for the popular retired municipal councillor will be held Thursday, at 2 p.m., from the Whattam Funeral Home, here, with Reverend Ed Horton of Picton United Church officiating. Interment will be in the Rose Cemetery at Waupoos.
