Intell typesetter for more than 20 years

Robert Donald McCann, a former employee of The Intelligencer, died Monday.

McCann, 47, of 42 Elgin St., worked as a linotype operator for 27 years at The Intell. He left his position in the summer of 1977.

McCann then worked for Canadian General Electric in

Trenton for four years. He had just started employment as a custodian at the Royal Canadian Legion, of which he was an associate member.

Born in Madoc, McCann was the son of Mrs. Margaret (Gawley) McCann and the late Thomas A. McCann. He is survived by wife, Margaret

E. Ballantyne, son Robert T. McCann, at home, daughter Penny Lee McCann, of Vancouver, B.C. and stepson Robert Miller, of Stirling.
