

McCullough, Ross

Former CPR Employee New Theatre Manager

With the retirement of George H. Forhan, theatre manager in Belleville for nearly half a century the Belle Theatre has a new manager.

He is 39-year-old Ross McCullough, native of Saint John, New Brunswick, who joined Famous Players last year following a varied career with the Canadian Pacific Railways and as private investigator with a Toronto law firm.

Mr. McCullough was assist-

ant manager at the Alhambra Theatre in Toronto before coming to Belleville late in February.

"Mr. Forhan was a wonderful theatre manager and was highly thought of by officials in the Famous Players theatre chain. I've got a lot to learn to match his ability," he said.

Mr. McCullough completed his elementary and high school education in Saint John and attended St. Anne College at Church Point, N.S. before joining the telecommunications department of Canadian Pacific. Over the next 19 years he worked up to chief clerk before being transferred to Toronto in 1962.
