Seventeen-year-old Jeremy McCutcheon will be given a military funeral today following a tragic air crash Saturday at CFB Mountain View.

The Belleville air cadet was killed along with pilot Capt. Marcus Lechner, 24, of Peterborough when their glider tow plane crashed late Saturday after towing gliders for the day.

McCutcheon, son of Jerome and Deware McCutcheon of O'Hare Street, was a member of the 608 Royal Canadian Air Cadet Squadron and was planning on applying for the Royal Canadian Air Cadet Flying Scholarship Program.

Today's funeral at Bridge St. United Church will be a military ceremony complete with cadet pall-bearers.

Investigators are still at the Mountain View scene.

Dave Rohrer of the Transportation Safety Board of Canada told the Toronto Star that damage to the plane showed that Lechner possibly had recovered from a spin but hit the ground before he could pull out of a dive.

Rohrer told The Star that the plane lost flying speed during a turn, causing it to spin to the ground.
