Popular businessman dies

This city will say its final farewell to one of its prominent businessmen Saturday. The funeral for Lorne McDougall of 317A Dundas St. West, long-time owner of Lorne McDougall Insurance Ltd., will be held from the Bush Funeral Home to St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church for service at 11 a.m.

Mr. McDougall, 85, died Wednesday in Belleville General Hospital. A native of North Bay, Mr. McDougall obtained a degree in commerce from Queen's University in 1928, and after a short time with a paper mill at Hull, joined a company of Queen's friends in the insurance business here, later buying out his partners.

His community service includes two terms as alderman, 45-year member and a past president of the Kiwanis Club of Belleville, past chairman of the Albert College Board of Governors, past chairman of the YMCA board, and a director for some years on the Plainfield Children's Home.

Surviving are his wife, Doris; son, Ross, who has been heading the business for about the past 10 years; daughter Anne, of Ottawa; one grandchild; and sisters Mabel, Belleville, and Alice, Toronto. He was predeceased by five brothers.
