### ***Time Capsule***

These photographs show a young Belleville man before and after leaving for the First World War. Unlike his brother David who was killed on the front, Arthur McGlashon of Belleville was wounded on Aug. 19, 1916 at Dieppe. He served with the 39th Battalion and was fighting with the 46th Battalion when he was injured. Arthur recuperated at the Queen's Military Hospital in Kingston (in photo in wheelchair), before returning to Belleville where he lived until his death in 1957. These photos come to us from Rev.
