They settled in Prince Edward and many of their descendants still reside in the county.

"Through the interest and generosity of a number of these persons, it was possible to procure pictures which helped to make the narratives come alive and to reveal the

ratives come alive and to reveal the Milford area as it was long ago,"

Thompson says. The book traces the descendants of John Miller's son, John Stuart Miller and his wife, Sarah Snider, from 1846 to 1987. The couple had nine children and, with marriages, many other names appear in the family history

Thompson describes the book as a

co-operative effort.
"Everyone contacted showed a fine spirit and a genuine interest in local history," she says.
