## Gene Morosan dies at age 63

The funeral for prominent local politician and educator Eugene (Gene) Morosan, was scheduled for today at 1 p.m. from the Burke Funeral Home at 30 Moira St, West.

Morosan, a resident of Belleville for many years, died Friday, April 1, in Belleville General Hospital at the age of 63.

Employed for some years by the Hastings County Board of Education, Mr. Morosan also operated a private marriage and family practice as a psychologist. His teaching included terms at Quinte Secondary School and at Loyalist College.

Morosan ran as Quinte riding candidate for the New Democratic Party in two consecutive provincial elections, but not in the last one in 1990 because of failing health. He also sought election to Belleville City Council on two occasions.

Friends describe Morosan as a devout Quaker, who was active in activities associated with various churches in the city. He was also an active member of the Lions Club of Belleville.

Surviving are daughter Carol Zachernuk and her husband, Philip, Toronto; son David, of British Columbia; sister, Sylvia Pacurar of Hamilton, and one grandson, Alexander.
