

MPP honors Harry Mulhall in legislature

TORONTO -- MPP Jim Pollock paid tribute in the legislature Thursday to Harry Mulhall, saying The Intelligencer's city editor was "a credit to his profession."

Pollock (PC-Hastings-Peterborough) praised Mulhall for his fair and accurate writing and added that under his guidance The Intelligencer gave equal coverage to the four political ridings in the Quinte area.

"Harry Mulhall was a credit to his profession, the community in which he lived and was a devoted family man," said Pollock.

"He took a keen interest in the workings of the Ontario legislature and he will be sorely missed."

Mulhall, 53, died unexpectedly in Belleville General Hospital Wednesday. Funeral is being held today at 2 p.m. at St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church.

Political stories were a Mulhall trademark. Only last Monday he called Pollock for comment on his appointment as Conservative critic for natural resources.
