

Harry Mulhall dead at 53

Belleville today lost one of her best-known citizens.

Harry Mulhall, 53, The Intelligencer's city editor, died unexpectedly in Belleville General Hospital shortly before press time today.

Mulhall was the dean of the area's journalistic community, having covered the region's activities for more than three decades. He started at The Intelligencer in 1962. Before that, his journalism career included stints with radio station CJBQ, Canadian Press and a variety of Northern Ontario newspapers.

Mulhall is survived by wife Mary and children Maggie, Simon and Nicholas.
