City council passed a motion Monday to propose the Moira River Conservation Authority consider naming its newest ice control dam after former Intelligencer city hall reporter and city editor Harry Mulhall. Ald. Kay Manderville proposed the dedication for the dam, currently under construction just south of Highway 401 on the Moira River, noting Mulhall, who died in 1987, was deeply involved in MRCA activities and conservation. Council passed the motion to refer the proposal to the MRCA unanimously.
