MRCA will name new dam after journalist

The Moira River Conservation Authority has officially adopted the name suggested by Belleville city council for the authority's nearly-completed No. 2 dam on the Moira — the Harry Mulhall Dam.

Named after long-time reporter and city editor for The Intelligencer, the dam will be marked with a commemorative plaque before its official opening Oct. 22.

Mulhall, who died Nov. 4, 1987, was best known as The Intelligencer's city hall reporter, an institution he covered for nearly two decades before his promotion to city editor in 1983. His dedication to his job and his widespread community involvement included tenure on the authority's public information and education committee.

Authority manager Dave King says construction of the ice-control dam — one of a series being constructed on the Moira — will be completed in about two weeks. The dam is immediately south of Highway 401.
