Rev. H. J. Marner, July 1917 - June 1920

Mrs. A. Emery advocated Sunday School all year.

Two or three years this was done.

\* 1892 - Larger brick church built - membership 77.

The Sunday School enrolled 98.

Sunday School classrooms upstairs - estimated cost \$4500.

\* The following persons laid corner stones now on a stone tablet in the east entrance of the church.
