

The organisation of Aldershot Industrial Installations Limited was a natural and necessary development evolving from the ever increasing scope of Aldershot Equipment's operations. Messrs. A. Voytek and R. D. Stewart are also Vice-Presidents of the company and manage the Electrical and Mechanical divisions respectively.

Mr. R. B. Mesley is Manager of the Millwrighting and Rigging Division.

Mrs. S. Carr is the company's Secretary-Treasurer.

The directors are Messrs. R. A. Henderson, W. E. Weatherley, A. Voytek, R. D. Stewart and A. Skinner of Chagnon, MacGillivray and Company the company's Chartered Accountants.

In little more than two years Aldershot Industrial Installations Limited has grown to one of the largest firms of this nature in the area employing an office staff of thirty people and field forces ranging in number up to two hundred and seventy men.

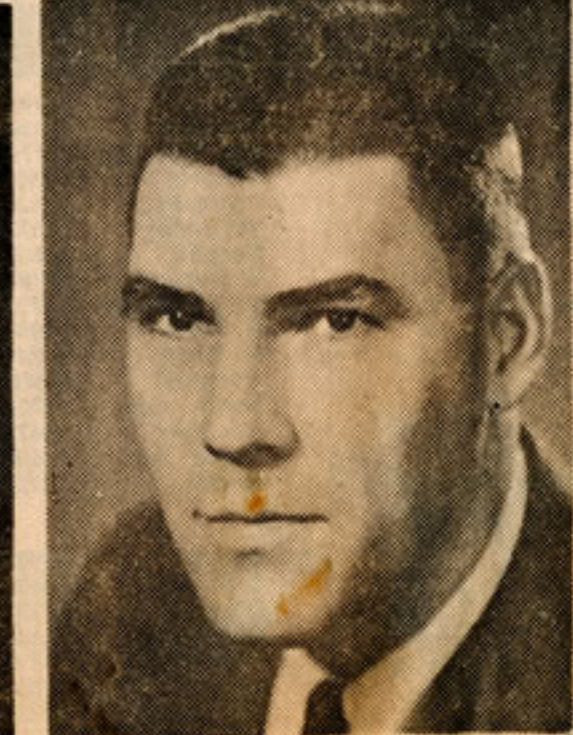
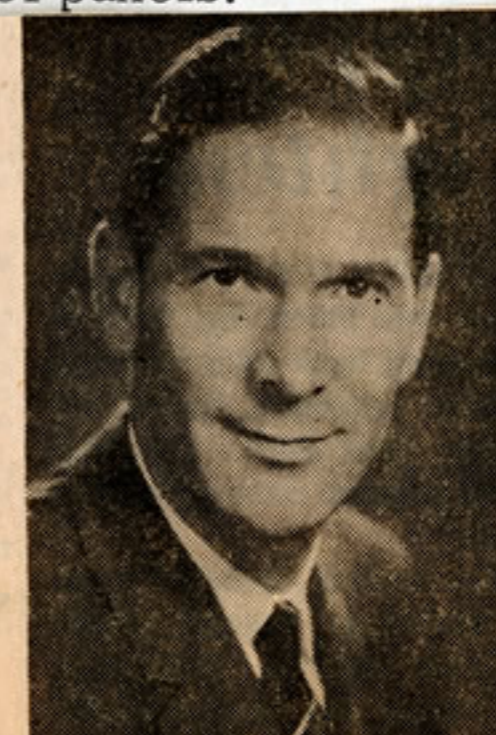
