Citizens of Burlington

Dear Fellow Citizens,

1965 is the fiftieth anniversary of Burlington's incorporation as a Town. At birth there were 2150 people, there are now over 55,000. This increase statistically indicates the exciting growth of this municipality during its first half century.

Future growth will be even more startling. By 1970 Burlington will have a population of 83,000 people, by 1975 an estimated 110,000 and by 1980 just under 150,000.

Burlington has made plans to accomodate such development. This is demonstrated by our existing and planned education, recreation and park, sewage, storm drainage, roads, and administration facilities. They will ensure a minimum of expense to the present and future ratepayers.
