

Morley Delbert Ward whose home is at Haliburton, Ontario, enlisted for service with the Canadian Army on July 10, 1941.

He was promoted from the rank of Private to that of Bombardier. He trained in Canada at Peterboro Ont., Petawawa, Ont., and Debert, N.S.

Bdr Ward was sent overseas on August 19, 1943. He served with the army in the United Kingdom and also saw action against the enemy in Continental Europe.

Bdr Ward trained as a fitter machinist and gun fitter. While in the service he transferred from the 6th Anti-Tank R.C.A. to the 45th Field Bty.

For his service Bdr Ward was given the 1939-45 Star and the France and Germany Star, the Defence Medal, and the Cdn Volunteer Service Medal and Clasp.

Bdr Ward arrived home from overseas
