Matt Sergeant Is Missing

Flying Officer Mathew Frederick E. Sergeant, whose wife lives in Bobcaygeon, has been reported missing on active service overseas April 5, it was learned today. The 21-year-old air gunner is the second former member of St. John's Church Rover Crew to be reported a casualty in recent weeks.

The son of Mr. and Mrs. Mathew Sergeant, George street, he enlisted in August, 1942, and trained at Brantford, Toronto, Mountain View, where he did instructional work, Quebec City, and Mount Joli. He graduated at the latter station, and received his commission last June. He went overseas in August, 1944, but it is believed he started his tour of operations in February of this year.

Flying Officer Sergeant was born in Campbellford, but came to Peterborough nine years ago. While in Campbellford, he took both Cub and Boy Scout training under his father. In Peterborough, he was an assistant Cubmaster at St. John's Anglican Church, and also an enthusiastic member of the Rover Crew.

Before enlisting, he was employed at the Peterborough Lock Company. His wife was formerly Helen Henderson, of Bobcaygeon.
