DECLARATION TO BE MADE BY MAN ON ATTESTATION.

*Thomas George Richter*, do solemnly declare that the above statements made by me to the above questions and that they are true, and that I am willing to fulfil the engagements by me made and I hereby engage and agree to serve in the Canadian Overseas Expeditionary Force, not to be attached to any form of land service, for the term of one year, or during the war now existing between Great Britain and Germany should that war last longer than one year, and for six months after the termination of the war provided that the Government should so long require my services, to and, legally discharged.
