Mrs. L. Phillips, 72 Albert St., S., is expecting her son, Pte. Don home from overseas at any time now. She advises the Post that he has fought in Germany, France and Holland and was wounded last summer in the left arm and right hip.

Pte. Phillips will receive his 30-day furlough and spend it with his mother before going on to the Pacific.

Another son, Fred, has also joined the Pacific Forces and is now stationed at Chattam.

A third son Pte. Will Phillips returned home from overseas in January.

He is confined to Christie St. Hospital, Toronto suffering from battle injuries. While there he has met the nurse who first attended him overseas. She is now stationed in Toronto.

The reunion which will take place when all the boys get together will be the first time the whole family has been together in five years.
