

THE FRENCH TOBACCO IN RICHMOND TO BE DESTROYED

Washington, May 14. The French Minister has intelligence from his Consul at Richmond to the effect that the rebel Government had informed him that should it be necessary to evacuate the city, the French tobacco would be destroyed with the town, but at the same time the rebels would pay for it, a proposition not relished by the Frenchmen.

The French Minister discredits the rumors of European intervention in our affairs, and it is generally thought here that whatever purposes may have been entertained by England and France, the news from New Orleans will cause their indefinite postponement.

Released Federal prisoners say the rebels are as determined as ever, and believe after two good months' fighting they will, if shipped, send the rebels to small, isolated posts and fight to the very last. They represent the treatment of our prisoners as barbarous in the extreme.

GENERAL HUNTER'S PROCLAMATION UNAUTHORIZED

Washington, May 14. The President indignantly has ordered the publication of the General's proclamation to be discontinued.

GEN. HUNTER TO BE RECALLED

(Special to the N. Y. Times.) Gen. Hunter's proclamation excites scarcely any interest in Washington—our attaching any importance as to its efficacy to produce the end desired. Hunter has no forces at all, and his proclamation is a mere declaration of independence.

His declaring freedom to all the slaves in three States, when he has no power to free a single one outside of his camp, is regarded in Washington as an act of intemperance, highly discredit to any one holding the rank of general, and supposed to have originated in the President's policy in opposition to the Executive case, in which all his Cabinet concurred.

Washington, May 14. The Hunter proclamation has presented an unenviable issue, which it is believed, will result in the breaking up of the Cabinet.

The President has expressed not only dissatisfaction but indignation. It is stated positively that Gen. Hunter will be recalled.

The Delta of the 14th says that business in New Orleans is generally suspended; most of the banks are closed, and the city everywhere presents a sad appearance. The port office remains open guarded by marines. The telegraph offices are closed, and railroad travel is stopped.

New York, May 14.—A destructive fire has been raging for some days past on Long Island. About 60,000 acres has been burned over, involving a loss of from \$300,000 to \$100,000.

Cincinnati, May 13.—The Commercial Advertiser of the following Southern news:—

The Memphis Aetna of the 6th inst., says that the telegraphic news from Richmond is painfully significant. Gen. McClellan seems to have been preparing the same fact for Richmond, that Gen. Butler and Com. Porter got up for New Orleans.

Mayor Morton and all the Aldermen of New Orleans have been arrested for refusing to take the oath of allegiance to the United States, and sent to prison.

Philadelphia, May 19.—The Bulletin contains the following additional from Fortress Monroe:—The repairs of the gunboats is generally regarded as a very serious affair. On the Naugatuck seventeen are reported killed by the explosion of the gun; the boat was destroyed. The Clatsop was riddled with shots, and the loss is supposed to be heavy. The Monitor was struck repeatedly, but is said to be uninjured.

Affairs are quiet at Norfolk. There have been several attempts lately to assassinate Union soldiers.

THE RUMORS OF INTERVENTION.

The Washington correspondent of the New York Times denies the allegation that England and France intend to intervene in United States affairs. He says:—

There is nothing of it. Our relations with each country are most amicable, and the communications from France, out of which the rumor has sprung, are wholly unimportant, and amount only to the usual desire on the part of the French interests that the United States should be friendly to the French Republic.

Yves Sarracens.—About a year and a half ago, the brig Aurora sailed from Gibraltar for New York with a cargo of fruit. Nothing having been heard of her subsequently, it was supposed that she was lost at sea. The vessel and cargo were insured for \$20,000 in offices in New York, and in due time the money was paid over to the broker authorized to receive it, after which the whole matter was forgotten.

The New York Express states that the identical captain and identical crew of that identical brig, from that identical port, have been placed on trial in the British West India for three trading. Nothing is said of the vessel.

A Lady Committed to Prison.—At St. Louis recently a young lady was committed to prison for the crime of waving her handkerchief to a party of prisoners.
