The Victoria County Council is called to meet on Tuesday, the 23rd inst. This is a little earlier than usual, but as a meeting was required for the purpose of submitting the Huron and Quebec Railway by-law to the people, it was decided to hold the December session at the same time.

The Quebec Province Court of Revision dismissed with costs the petition of Ryan et al. to have Mr. E. Devin disqualify, the court putting no credence in the statements of the witness Murphy, on whom the petitioners relied for sufficient proof to disqualify the witness.

At the recent Wentworth session the corporation of Dundas was sued by Mrs. Boyce for injury sustained by her child, who fell from a defective sidewalk last winter and broke her leg.

The speech from the throne at the opening of the Quebec legislature yesterday was very brief and unimportant. The only paragraph of importance referred to the action of the Government in assuming, subject to legislative ratification, the construction of the Montreal and Ottawa Railway.

Mr. W. Mackenzie has grown modest and moderate; or his oratorical modesty is being broken in. In the midst of wild Tory exultation in Toronto Saturday night, he made in his speech an allusion to Ontario politics and stated that although the Opposition might not get command of a majority there, they would be so strong in numbers that the Government would not venture to do anything very wrong.
