WHAT IS CORDOVAN LEATHER?

ANSWER.—The finest Shoe Upers are obtained out of the muscle or shell part of the hide, which begins at the root part of the tail and runs egg-shaped to the hip bone and down to the hind leg. Only the horse family, such as the zebra, quagga, gnu, etc., have this muscle; in fact, this shell or muscle laying between the grain and the flesh, tightly woven to the grain part of the hide, gives that family their great strength and elasticity. The uppers cut out of this shell are finished and blackened on the shell or flesh side, while the rest part of the hide is finished for many different purposes on the grain side. This muscle or shell is the most durable leather in existence, and is also most impregnable to water.


