EDITORIAL NOTES. The Quebec provincial elections are to take place during the first two weeks of August.

A \$4,000 MISTAKE. A Montreal commercial paper recently made a very curious charge to the effect that a Montreal importing firm involved in alleged custom house frauds had paid \$4,000 as in effect a bribe to get out of their difficulties and to stop further prosecution.

Two days after the Prime Minister's final election the Dominion government decided that the tunnel scheme to connect the island with the mainland was impracticable.

The doctrine of non-interference of Dominion ministers in local elections has been widely shocked by the following characteristic letter to a Prince Edward Island paper.

Some of the Tory organs boldly assert that the John A. who wrote the letter is not the chief, but that in reality, too much. The Tory "victory" in the island has simmered down to seventeen voters elected to thirteen liberal, with one of the local ministers rejected.

Mr. J. C. Dent's "Story of the Upper Canadian Rebellion" magnified Rolph and belittled Wm. Lyon Mackenzie, popularly considered the leader and hero of the struggle.

Judge DEAN proceeded to say that it was clear there was no collusion as to filing the names with his clerk. They were undoubtedly filed on the 10th, because they had the clerk's initials to the effect that they could have been brought to him and been initialled.

Mr. J. E. Thorold Rogers, the well-known author and Oxford professor, has sent to the correspondent of a New York paper the following letter in response to a request for his opinion in regard to the present aspect of the home rule question.

The remaining elections have increased the majority against Mr. Gladstone. The figures now stand: Conservatives, 323; Liberal-Unionists, 73; Gladstonians, 188; Parallels, 86.
