SIR CHARLES TUPPER'S BUDGET SPEECH—THE IRON TAX—HEAVY PROTECTION—AN ENORMOUS INCREASE IN ALARMING OUTLOOK—SIR RICHARD CARTWRIGHT'S REVIEW—THE OPEN COUNTRY CASE—MR. RYKERT.

OTTAWA, May 16, 1887.

Sir Charles Tupper, the new finance minister, delivered his budget speech on Thursday last. Sir Charles has all his old force of display and makes a good deal of display as of yore, but the tremendous force of the iron tax and the method shown throughout the rather threadbare attempt at enthusiasm and belief in his own cause. This budget speech will long be remembered as involving even more daring efforts in the direction of protection than ever have been made before.

The iron tax, the tax on coal, the subsequent tax and bounty upon iron, have all been done by the proposed system of taxation and bounty upon iron which have come into effect now that the budget has been definitely announced. It might have been expected that a gamster so fond of desperate chances as Sir Charles Tupper would have proposed something startling in the way of change, but nobody seems to have expected for a moment that he would make the fatal move which he made on Thursday with the sanction of the government and his own party.

The duty of protection is doubled with a view as it is called, of promoting the iron smelting industry and developing the great iron mines and deposits of the Dominion. Sir Charles pretended to believe that this would mean the production of iron in a raw state for the many manufacturers of which it is the basis, but he failed to mention that this could be done without making it certain that for a number of years at least this raw material of manufacture would be enormously increased in price. Iron at every stage of manufacture is a raw material for some manufacturing producer and, of course, it reaches his hands with the profit of the manufacturer. It is the labor expended upon it, but upon the taxation to which it has been subjected. The taxation of \$3 a ton at the pig iron stage would increase the cost of iron to \$10 when it reached the third or fourth stage, forming an amount of increase, the result of which it is almost impossible to foresee. If it is the intention of the government that manufacturers require the present duties to save them from American competition it seems absolutely certain that these duties will have to be raised or freed if the new scale of taxing the raw material is to be maintained. It may be that this is the object at which the government has been directly aiming, for there seems to be no other reason why the government should have increased the duties to such an extent.

It was generally understood that C. J. Rykert, the notorious of Lincoln, was to be appointed deputy-speaker. THE CROCKERY TRADE. The crockery men of the Dominion are dissatisfied with the duties on crockery. They want it changed from specific to ad valorem, so that it may be levied on the goods equally all round. The law, too, is somewhat difficult to interpret, and the consequence has been that errors and misunderstandings too often creep up between those in the business and the customs officers. As a result of this, the crockery trade throughout the Dominion and the government.

THE IRON INDUSTRY. The city is already flooded with delegations to interview the government against any changes that have been made in the tariff. One of the most important is that in regard to the iron industry, and from all the leading cities it is contended that the doubling of the iron duties will paralyze the trade of the Dominion. The proprietors of the Montreal and Hamilton rolling mills view the tax as equivalent to a complete stoppage of the whole business. The delegation will meet Sir Charles Tupper and lay their grievances before him.

THE DUTY OF SALT. The Ontario manufacturers of salt who wanted a remission of the tariff, claim that the additional duty of 10 ounces American salt imposed by the Canada Government is very heavy. They claim that it is quite contrary to the spirit of the tariff, and that it would be a great boon. Such is the power of talk with an audience of Tory members of parliament.

A NEEDED WARNING. In reply to the finance minister Sir Richard Cartwright made a necessary speech which will doubtless receive, as it deserves, the attention of the vast body of thinking Canadians. He showed that the expenditure on the railways was not the debt but a good deal more than that; the public works on which the expenditure had been made had either been given away or worked at a loss; taxation had been enormously increased; the price of products
