Assays of the gold vein recently discovered in McKean's township, near Dundas and Muskoka, have produced very satisfactory results.

The agitation against the payment of tithes in Denbigh, Wales, is increasing. Tithing had to be called out on Friday to disperse a crowd.

Lord Curzon, who had been summoned to answer the enquiry at Charlottetown, when challenged was shot dead. While the emperor is staying there the military rule is flexible.
