Ontario. We regret to have to chronicle this week the death of Mr. Henry Hughes, an old and respected citizen, who succumbed on Saturday last to the effects of a stroke of apoplexy received some two weeks ago, and from which he never rallied. Deceased was born in the seaport town of Devon, in the county of Devon, England, in the year 1812, and followed a military life at an early age. When eighteen years old he joined the Royal Artillery, and shortly afterwards was drafted to the service for four or five years in Kingston, where he rose to the rank of sergeant in the corps. Later on he left the service and married Miss McLean, a member of one of the old families (who survives him), and established himself in the auction business, which he followed for some years. About 1860 he came to Lindsay, then a place of small importance - where his energy, judgment and experience speedily made him a valued citizen. He was appointed clerk of the court by Judge Smith, a position which he retained up to the time of his death. At the time of the Fenian troubles he joined the militia, where his military training was of the greatest service, and he remained a member of the force until about four years ago, when he was allowed to retire with the rank of captain, which title he retained to the end of his life.
