Labrador Lighthouse Life. Mr. J. U. Gregory, naval agent at Quebec, has contributed to the New York Forest and Stream some interesting sketches of Labrador life. He says of the lighthouse keepers :

I have known a well educated man, born and brought up near Quebec, formerly a storekeeper, married to an educated woman, who accepted a situation as lighthonse keeper on the Island of Auticosti, and afterward obtained, through family inflaence, a good government appointment with sufficient remuneration to enable him to bring up his family well and live comfortably, actually shed tears when he left his isolated island home, and a year afterward trying to get back his former position; but I have also known others to go out of their minds from the dreariness and monotony of their lives. They were invariably men. Women appear to bear up better, and frequently do the most of the work, heaving the station in order. the work, keeping the eighten in order while their husbands look the picture of increased wages at TJsassa, Texas. Again, there are some stations, where husband, wife and children seem to be perfectly contented, the family well educated and even accomplished in music and other refinements. They are well supplied with literature, and their conversation is free from slang so often noticeable in townbred people.


