There exists in Toronto a so-called immigration office, which if reports be true carries on quite a little business at the expense of the Government. The usual rats of steerage passage from Liverpool to Canada is \$27. The immigration agent undertakes to sell one for \$25, and this is how he does it. A person goes to him and states that he wants to pay a friend's passage across from Liverpool. He pays his \$25 and receives in return a printed letter which is to be sent to the intending immigrant.
