CRICKET. A well attended meeting of the cricket club was held at the Forest house, on Wednesday evening...

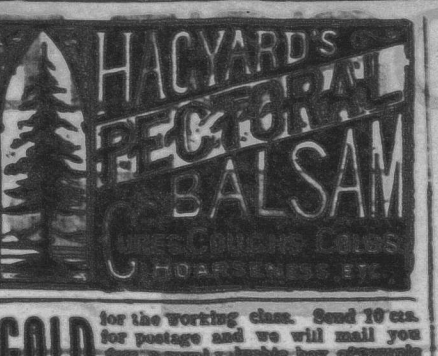
